MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN SCHOOL DISTRICT OF NORTH POSEY COUNTY, INDIANA

Held July 28, 1980

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana, was held in the office of the Superintendent of schools on the 28th day of July, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 p.m., with Board Members Eisterhold, Newman, Hall, Nash, and Martin present. Also attending were Superintendent Brenton and School Attorney Johnson.

The meeting was called to order by President Eisterhold who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of July 2, 1980, were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims

Claims No. 23-65 in the amount of \$11,508.20, Cumulative Building Fund Claims No. 62-63 in the amount of \$533.50, and Transportation Fund Claims No. 6-10 in the amount of \$5,959.96, were presented to the Board for consideration, and upon motion duly made by Newman, seconded by Hall, and unanimously carried were approved by the Board and ordered paid.

Additional Appropriation

The President called to the attention of the Board to the fact that this was the time advertised for hearing on the proposed emergency appropriation in the amount of \$16,000.00 in account no. 25300 - Cumulative Building Fund. There were no remonstrances against the proposed emergency appropriation and following a discussion, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, it was determined by the Board that such a need did exist and an additional appropriation in the amount of \$16,000.00 in account no. 25300 - Cumulative Bulding Fund was made by the Board. The Superintendent was instructed to forward the necessary copies of the resolution and of the proofs of publication to the Auditor of Posey County, for additional hearing before the State Board of Tax Commissioners.

1981 Budget Approval

The Superintendent presented to the Board the recommended budget for the year 1981 and gave a comparison for the budget levies for the year 1980 and 1981 as follows:
