Executive Session

The Board convened the Executive Session at 5:30 p.m. at North Elementary School for the purpose of discussion of strategy with respect to threatened litigation as well as to receive information about a perspective employee. The Board adjourned Executive Session at 6:30 p.m.

Regular Meeting

The Board of Education convened for the regular meeting at 6:42 p.m. with President, Geoff Gentil, calling the meeting to order with the initiation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Patron Concerns

Peyton Straw, Melissa Alexander, Aaron Wilson, Casey Winegar, and Chasidy Davis all addressed the Board regarding their thoughts on masks in the schools. All were against the students being mandated to wear masks in school. In addition to the masks, Melissa Alexander expressed that parents should be allowed to once again eat lunch with their children. She also wants further clarification on the quarantine guidelines now that masks are once again optional.

Mrs. Will made a motion to approve the consent items as presented and Mr. Schmitt seconded the motion. The motion passed 5 to 0.

New Business

Mrs. Koester, Mrs. MacMunn, Mrs. Walden, and Mr. Galvin presented for consideration the recommendation for a full day Preschool/Pre-Kindergarten Program. Mr. Kahle made a motion to approve the request and Mr. Oakley seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mrs. Walden presented Sean Fisher's request for consideration the proposal to permit North Posey High School sponsored IHSAA sport, cheerleading, dance, guard, and marching band activities to replace a Physical Education credit. Mr. Oakley made a motion to table the request and Mr. Kahle seconded the motion. The motion to table passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mrs. Walden, on behalf of Mr. Fisher, Mr. Kavanaugh, and herself, presented for consideration the proposal to study an Alternative Education Option for the 2022-2023 school year. Mr. Oakley made a motion to approve the request and Mr. Schmitt seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mr. Galvin presented for consideration two options of the North Posey High School Athletic Handbook submitted by Mr. Fisher. Specific language for consideration appears on page 10 of each

option. Mr. Fisher recommends "option 1" be approved, retaining the language that requires student-athletes take the strength and conditioning course after their freshman PE requirements are met. Mr. Schmitt made a motion to approve the Athletic Handbook "option 1" and Mr. Oakley seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mrs. Walden presented Mr. Fisher's request for consideration the recommendation to allow club swimming to continue, as currently operating at North Posey High School. Swimmers would provide their own equipment, transportation, and coaching, combined with assistance from the NPHS athletic department to provide IHSAA compliance and scheduling assistance to compete in swimming. Mrs. Will made a motion to approve the request and Mr. Kahle seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mr. Galvin presented for consideration the Under Armour/BSN Agreement for team apparel and spirit wear. Mr. Kahle made a motion to approve the request and Mrs. Will seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mrs. Walden presented for consideration the Use of School Buses by Nonprofit Organizations policy, which outlines procedures for allowing outside organizations to request school transportation for their needs. Mr. Oakley made a motion to approve the policy and Mr. Schmitt seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mr. Galvin presented for consideration the bids for North Posey High School Chiller Replacement project. Sealed bids were opened in the Board Office on Wednesday, February 2, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. Bids were received from four bidders; Custom Mechanical, Deig Brothers, Harrell-Fish Inc. and DeBra-Kuempel. The Stenftengal Group submitted the Bid Summary Sheet and their recommendation for the Board to review. Mr. Galvin recommended the Board accept the bid from the low bidder, Harrell-Fish, Inc, as recommended by The Stenftenagel Group. Mr. Schmitt made a motion to approve the recommendation and Mr. Kahle seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Mr. Galvin presented for consideration the proposals for lawn care for 2022. Sealed bids were opened in the Board Office on Wednesday, February 9, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. The following bids were received:

Mrs. Murray will have a prorated contract for the 2021-2022 school year to be calculated once a start date can be determined. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, she will have a 240-day contract of \$80,000.00 and will be eligible for any applicable compensation raise and/or stipend given to the administrative team in 2022-2023. She will receive the district level administrative benefit package. Mr. Oakley made a motion to approve the recommendation and Mrs. Will seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.
