LIVING BIOGRAPHIES

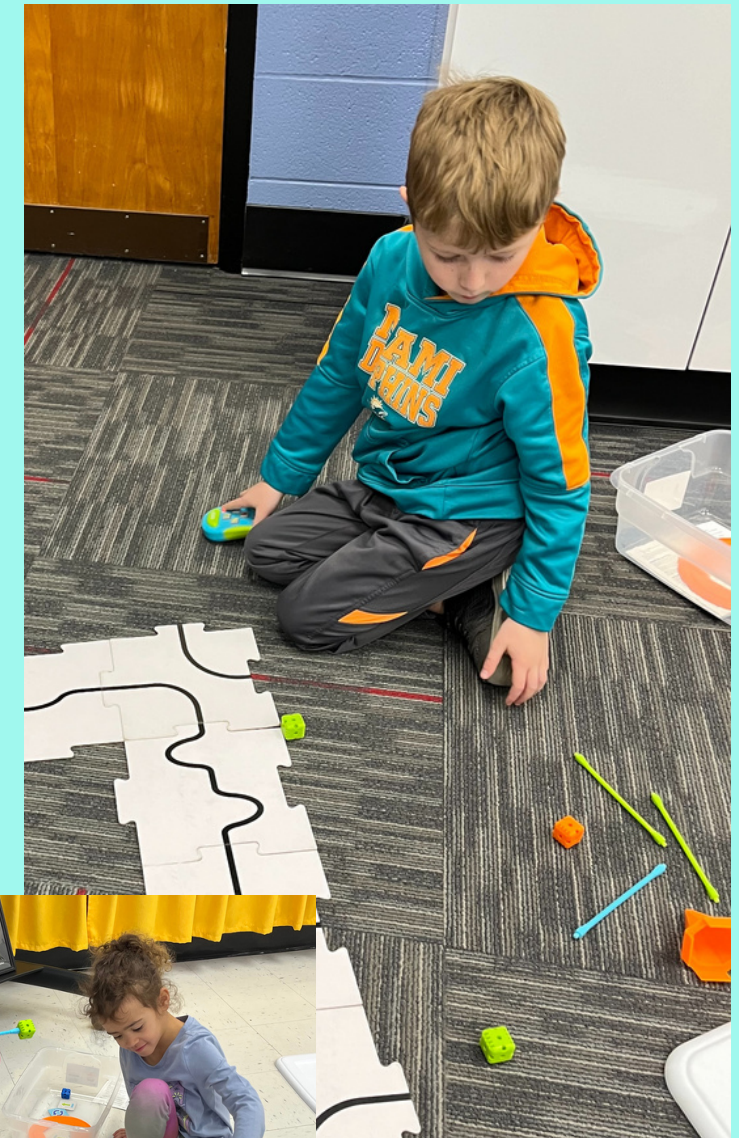
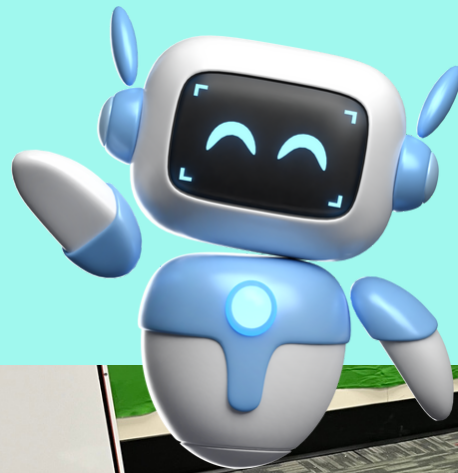
