What is

Ascension St. Vincent Tri State Clinics?

Ascension St. Vincent Tri State Clinic is a service that delivers convenient high-quality primary care directly to our employees and dependent family members who are age 2 or older.

Services include preventive and wellness-focused primary care services, care for sudden onset illnesses, chronic condition management such as high blood pressure, diabetes, high cholesterol, anxiety/depression, and allergies. Some labs and medications are also available.

What Can I Expect?

- Convenient access to online or phone scheduling
- Appointments are required. However, there are often same day/next day appointments available.
- Minimal wait times
- Convenient locations and a variety of hours of availability
- Clinic visits, a limited number of lab tests, & limited prescriptions are provided at no cost in the clinic.
- At your request, all medical records including lab tests can be sent to your personal physician or specialist.
- Initial office visits to establish care should be scheduled for 40 minutes.
- Follow-up & illness appointments will take 20 minutes.
- The clinic offers you a 24/7 Patient Support Line to reach a nurse or medical provider to assist you with your needs outside clinic hours.
- All services you receive are confidential.

Who is Eligible?

- All employees are eligible for the clinic.
- All spouses and dependents who are on the MSD North Posey insurance are eligible for the clinic.
- We provide Ascension a list of eligible employees and their dependent family members as well as designated retirees who are eligible to receive services. When you check in for each visit, the clinic staff will verify your eligibility. Please bring a photo ID.

Is There a Cost?

- Access to the Ascension St. Vincent Tri State Clinic is provided to you for no out-of-pocket cost.
- If you are referred to another provider, lab or pharmacy outside of the clinic, your normal health benefits will apply and there may be a deductible, co-pay or other out of pocket cost.

Can I get My Prescriptions at the Clinic?

- Clinic medications prescribed by the clinic provider, in the clinic formulary, and available at the time of your visit will be provided at your visit.
- Prescriptions will be written by the provider for medications not on the clinic formulary or available at the time of your visit. You will receive your medications from the provider whenever possible.
- The clinic does not fill prescriptions written by an outside provider. A visit and evaluation with the clinic provider is required before any medication needs are considered.

What Medications are Available?

Although you may not see your exact medication on your clinic's formulary, there is likely something that is similar that could also treat your medical condition. Please call the clinic to make an appointment with a provider.

Medication Refill Process

In order to best serve all patients, we request that you do not stop in the clinic for a refill without a scheduled appointment. Patients needing a refill must schedule an appointment at least 24 hours prior by going online or calling our Patient Support Team at **1-888-492-8722.**

When making an appointment, please list which medication(s) you need refilled. You must schedule an appointment with your provider every 6 months for ongoing conditions that require medication management.
