

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the
Board of Education of the Metropolitan
School District of North Posey County,
Indiana,

Held July 11, 1966

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The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana, was held on the 11th day of July, 1966, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock, P.M., in the office of the Superintendent of Schools. Attending were board members Tenison, Meredith, Wade, Fletchall, and Hall. Also attending were Superintendent Hollen and Attorney Schuler.

The meeting was called to order by President Tenison, who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of June 30 were read to the board and upon motion duly made by Wade, seconded by Hall, and unanimously carried, were approved.


Regular claims No. 3 through No. 27 inclusive, Title I claims No. 61 and 62, and Title II claims No. 8 through No. 12 were presented to the board for consideration, and upon motion by Fletchall, seconded by Hall and unanimously carried, were approved by the board, signed and ordered paid.

The Superintendent reported receipt of letter of resignation from Mr. and Mrs. Jan Blackburn, who had recently been hired as Guidance Counselor and Elementary school teacher. This resignation was accepted by the board. The Superintendent recommended to the board the hiring of Miss Sharon Mountcastle as a First grade teacher at South Terrace. Following a short discussion, the board directed that Miss Mountcastle be hired and executed a contract in her behalf.


The Superintendent reported to the Board that the water system at South Terrace school had broken down and was in the process of being repaired by Don Little & Company, the original installer of the well.

A discussion was held by the board on several matters relating to school business, and the Superintendent reported to the board that it was likely that the new Vo Ag teacher would want to attend a workshop for beginning Vo Ag teachers to be held at Purdue University on July 25 through July 29. Permission was granted by the board for the teacher to attend this meeting.

Thereafter, on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned at the hour of nine o'clock, P.M.

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE METROPOLITAN

Held July 25, 1966

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The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the

Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana, was held on the 25th day of July, 1966, in the office of the Superintendent of Schools at the hour of 7:30 o'clock, p.m., with board members Tenison, Meredith, Hall, Wade and Fletchall present. Also attending were Superintendent Hollen and Attorney Schuler.

The meeting was called to order by President Tenison, who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of July 11, 1966, and of the special meeting of July 18, 1966, were read to the board, and approved as read.

Payroll vouchers and claims No. 29 through No. 45 were presented to the board for consideration, and upon motion duly made by Fletchall, seconded by Hall, and unanimously carried, were allowed, signed by the board, and ordered paid.

The Superintendent recommended the hiring of Jerry Craddock for the Guidance Department, stating that Mr. Craddock had six years of experience in teaching, and had indicated his readiness to accept the contract. The Superintendent further stated that there was one more Math teacher needed at the high school in order to complete the staff, and that he had a good lead for a person to fill this vacancy. He also recommended the hiring of bus drivers Leonard Stoneberger to replace Leslie Pritchett, and of Joe Arnold to take care of a surplus, or overflow route, originating in the St. Wendel area. Following a general discussion, on motion duly made by Fletchall, seconded by Wade, and carried, the board agreed to hire these individuals, and contracts were signed.

The Superintendent then reviewed the budget for the year 1967 with the board, giving explanations for the various items contained therein. Following an extended discussion, upon motion by Fletchall, seconded by Hall, and unanimously carried, the budget was approved, and publication ordered.

The annual state report, form 9A - Section 2, was presented to the board for consideration, and signed by the treasurer.

The Superintendent reviewed a letter he proposed to send to all bus drivers, notifying them that they would be required to attend a two-day safety meeting, or workshop, at Boonville, on August 4 and 5.

Thereafter, following a discussion on other school business, upon motion by Fletchall, seconded by Wade, and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned.
