

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE

Held September 8, 1980

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 8th day of September, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., with Board Members Eisterhold, Newman, Hall, Nash, and Martin present. Also attending were Superintendent Brenton, Administrative Assistant Rapp, and School Attorney Johnson.

The meeting was called to order by President Eisterhold who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of August 28, 1980 were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims

General Fund Claims No. 191-242 in the amount of \$9,660.72, Transportation Fund Claims No. 25-33 in the amount of \$4,235.07, Cumulative Building Fund Claims No. 243-253 in the amount of \$13,752.83 and Public Law 94-142 Claims No. 3-4 in the amount of \$107.65 were presented to the Board for consideration, and upon motion duly made by Newman, seconded by Hall and unanimously carried were approved by the Board and ordered paid.

All-Weather Track

Mr. Brenton reported that the final striping and numbering of the lanes on the all-weather track would be done on Wednesday of this week and that this would complete the installation. Board Members commented that they had received many favorable responses in regards to the installation of the all-weather track.

Vocational Education Evaluation

Mr. Rapp informed the Board that the three phases of our high school vocational education curriculum (Agriculture, Home Economics, and Office Education) would be evaluated by the State Department of Vocational Education during the month of April, 1981.

Recommendation of Roberta Weedman

Upon the recommendation of John Wood and the concurrence of Superintendent Brenton, the Board approved the employment of Roberta Weedman as High School extracurricular bookkeeper to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Virginia Sawyer.


Executive Session

At 8:15 p.m. it was the decision of the Board to go into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing personnel and other administrative matters.


At 8:45 p.m. the Board secured from Executive Session.


Following no further discussion of school matters, upon motion duly made and seconded, the meeting adjourned at the hour of 8:45 p.m.

Held September 22, 1980

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 22nd day of September, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., with Board Members Eisterhold, Newman, Hall, Nash, and Martin present. Also attending were Superintendent Brenton, Administrative Assistant Rapp, and School Attorney Johnson.

The meeting was called to order by President Eisterhold who presided. Minutes of the previous meeting of September 8, 1980 were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims

General Fund Claims No. 254-297 in the amount of \$5,374.23, Transportation Fund Claims No. 34-39 in the amount of \$3,769.98, Cumulative Building Fund Claim No. 295 in the amount of \$58,733.70, Public Law 94-142 Claims No. 5-12 in the amount of \$3,008.73, Title I Claims No. 1-2 in the amount of \$834.99, and Public Law 89-313 Claim No. 20 in the amount of \$279.00 were presented to the Board for consideration, and upon motion duly made by Newman, seconded by Nash and unanimously carried were approved by the Board and ordered paid.

Completion of All Weather Track

Mr. Brenton reported to the Board that Midwest had completed the work on the all-weather track and the Board authorized the payment of Cumulative Building Fund Claim No. 295 in the amount of \$58,733.70. ✓

Title IV-B Approval

The Board authorized Mr. Rapp to make application for \$10,339 available to the district in Title IV-B funds for fiscal year 1981.

Report on Transportation

Mr. Rapp reported that the bus garage was preparing for the annual School Bus Safety Inspection on Friday, September 26, 1980. He further reported that there was a 2 cent a gallon decrease in the cost of regular gasoline with the present price per gallon being \$1.104.

Red Cross Blood Drive

The Superintendent reported that the American Red Cross through the efforts of the North Posey Chapter of the National Honor Society secured 61 pints of blood during the blood drive on September 17th at North Posey High School.


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


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
