	Mr. Brenton reported to the Board concerning the volunteer work performed on the high school baseball diamond. There were 24 little league parents and players that worked for eight hours bringing the diamond into playing condition. The Board showed appreciation for a job well done.
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	Mr. Brenton reported to the Board on the progress being made on the high school roof. All work will be completed by July 17, 1981 and final inspections will be made by August 1, 1981.
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	Mr. Brenton reported to the Board for Mr. Rapp, who was on vacation, concerning the propane gas proposal for the buses. After looking at many pros and cons on the matter, Mr. Rapp has recommended, and Mr. Brenton concurs, that the district delay the use of propane gas for another year. There is a real possibility of 1982 buses being assembled with propane gas factory installed, so the district will consider this matternnext year.
