The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Metropolitan School District of North Posey County, Indiana was held in the office of the Superintendent of Schools on the 4th day of January, 1982, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M with Board Members Eisterhold, Newman, Hall, Nash and Martin attending. Also in attendance were Superintendent Brenton and Administrative Assistant Rapp.

The meeting was called to order by President Eisterhold who presided. Minutes of the previous meetings of December 21, 1982, were read to the Board and approved as read.

Claims

General Fund Claims No. 7 - 14 in the amount of \$677.32 and Transportation Fund Claims No. 1 - 3 in the amount of \$92.06 were presented to the Board for consideration and upon motion duly made by Hall, seconded by Newman and unanimously carried were approved by the Board and ordered paid.

Utilities

Mr. Brenton presented copies of a monthly billing from the three utility companies that service the school district and explained the foumula used by each company for determining their rates.

Report on Maintenance

Mr. Brenton reported to the Board that the custodians had cleaned and waxed the floors in all the buildings during the holiday break. He further reported that there was a loss of \$3,706.06 (meat and frozen food) due to a malfunction of the walkin freezer at the High School and that the school district's insurance would probably pay for any loss over \$1,000.00.

Transportation Report

Mr. Rapp gave his monthly report on gasoline expended for the month of December. He also reminded the Board that bus bids would be received at the mext regularly scheduled Board meeting.

Special Education and Vocational Education Report

Mr. Brenton reported to the Board on the number of students enrolled in the various areas of Special Education. He further reported on the number of students enrolled in the Home Economics, Business Laboratory classes and Agriculture classes.

Half Day In-Service

Upon recommendation of Mr. Brenton the Board approved a half-day inservice day for all administrators and faculty members on March 19, 1982. The inservice program will be presented by Melinda Selbee and Dave Emmert, attorneys for the Indiana School Board Association.
