The Board convened the Executive Session at 5:30 p.m. for the purpose of IC 5-14- 1.5-6.1 (9) to discuss job performance and evaluation of individual employees. The Board adjourned Executive Session at 5:59 p.m.

## Regular Meeting

The Board of Education convened for the special meeting at 6:02 p.m. with Geoff Gentil calling the meeting to order with the initiation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Patron Comments**

Zach Helfert informed the Board that he conducted a Facebook poll regarding the turf field and let them know the majority were against the turf field. Sheryl Seib then addressed the Board and urged them to wait on deciding on the turf field until all bids are in.

#### **New Business**

Dr. Camp asked the Board to approve the estimate submitted by Greer's Flooring America to remove the existing carpet, water proof, and install new carpet in the eight (8) classrooms in the freshmen wing of North Posey High School for \$52,755.17. Upon a motion made by Mr. Oakley and seconded by Mrs. Will, the request was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Dr. Camp shared with the Board the results of the recent bid opening for the Field and Track project at North Posey Junior/Senior High School.

Dr. Camp recommended that the Board accept the bid from ARC Construction for the base track bid for \$197,950.00 with alternate 1 still under advisement. Dr. Camp also recommended the Board accept the bid from Sprinturf for the base turf installation bid totaling \$789,910.00. Upon a motion made by Mr. Schmitt and seconded by Mr. Stock, the recommendations were approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Dr. Camp asked the Board to approve the request from the high school academic coaches to take ten students to the State Academic Super Bowl Competition on May 3-4, 2019. The academic teams did very well at the area competition. The history, fine arts, math and interdisciplinary teams all placed first, the English team placed second and the science team placed fourth. Upon a motion made by Mr. Schmitt and seconded by Mr. Stock, the request was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Dr. Camp informed the Board that the junior high academic teams also performed very well at their area competition. They were the Class 3 champions with first place in English, math, science, social studies and interdisciplinary. The math and social studies teams both ranked third in the state and English and interdisciplinary ranked in the top 10. No action required.

Upon a motion made by Mrs. Will and seconded by Mr. Oakley, the requests were approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

- Dr. Strieter to hire Derek Sweeney as the varsity girls' soccer coach for 2019 soccer season
- Jerry Straw to hire Susan Hostettler as a temporary bus driver for the remainder of the 2018-2019 school year beginning April 29, 2019

Upon a motion made by Mrs. Will and seconded by Mr. Schmitt, the request was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.
