#### **Executive Session**

The Board convened the Executive Session at 5:30 p.m. for the purpose of IC 5-14- 1.5-6.1 (9) to discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. The Board adjourned Executive Session at 6:32 p.m.

## Regular Meeting

The Board of Education convened for the regular meeting at 6:38 p.m. with President, Greg Schmitt, calling the meeting to order with the initiation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Patron Concerns**

There were no patrons present to address the Board.

# **Student Recognition**

Traci Newcomer, North Elementary Fourth Grade Teacher, was present to recognize Parker Weber's recent accomplishment. Parker was the first student in Indiana to complete all 16 learning tracks in Rocket Math. Rocket Math is a program that helps students to learn math facts, including addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, and fractions. There have been only 20 students in the United States to meet this accomplishment and most of them have been middle school students. Parker showed the Board his trophy and certificate from Rocket Math and discussed his accomplishment with them.

Mr. Oakley made a motion to approve the consent items as presented and Mr. Kahle seconded the motion. The motion passed 5 to 0.

#### **New Business**

Dr. Galvin presented for consideration the preliminary proposal for Summer School 2023 to offer Category I summer school classes at all locations. The Department of Education defines Category I classes as Reading for grades 1-3 and any course that counts towards graduation, including Electives, for grades 9-12. The corporation will require the state minimum of at least 15 to 1 teacher to student ratio to offer the classes. Mrs. Will made a motion to approve the request and Mrs. Bowers seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Dr. Galvin presented for consideration a recommendation from Mr. Jake Riecken, Director of Technology, to accept the quote from Bluum USA, Inc for Algo IP solutions for intercom/paging/clock services. Although they did not submit the lowest bid, Mr. Riecken feels their digital system will better serve our needs in comparison to the Architectural Sales' analog system. Quotes were received from three (3) vendors.

Dr. Galvin indicated that most of this project, \$198,940.00, will be paid through the 2022 General Obligation Bond with the remainder of the cost to be paid through the Operations Fund. Mr. Oakley made a motion to approve the recommendation and Mrs. Bowers seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Dr. Galvin presented for consideration the 2023 Summer Projects. Mrs. Will made a motion to approve the request and Mr. Oakley seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.

Dr. Galvin presented for consideration the contract with AdTec for the Capital Asset Ledger Services for three years at the cost of \$7,850.00 per year for 2023, 2025, and 2027. Mrs. Will made a motion to approve the request and Mr. Oakley seconded the motion. The motion was approved with a 5 to 0 vote.
