

Important Parent Information



If you or your student need a transcript for **any reason**, it will need to be requested through Parchment. Seniors should already have an account. If your senior does not have a Parchment account, they need to see their counselor or Mrs. Rose ASAP to make one. Parchment

We encourage you to use the Harmony Parent Access System to have access to your child's grades, attendance, discipline, lunch account balance, and assignment summaries. Email your child's counselor to request information to set up your account if you have not already done so. If you do not have Internet access at home, you can set up a free email account at any public library. <u>Harmony Log In</u>

21st Century Scholars



COLLEGE DEADLINE

Check With the College

Visit the school's website or contact its financial aid office. School deadlines are usually early in the year, often in February or March, although some are even earlier. These are priority deadlines that could impact scholarships but not state or federal aid.

FEDERAL DEADLINE

June 30, 2024

The FAFSA form must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. Central time (CT) on June 30, 2024. Any corrections or updates must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. CT on Sept. 10, 2024. Filing between April 16 and the federal deadline will only potentially qualify students for federal aid; no state aid will be awarded.



Scholarships 101





- 1. This is a working document and will be updated often.
- 2. Scholarships due in the spring will not be available until closer to their deadlines.
- 3. You must pay attention to the deadlines. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- 4. Read the directions. Don't assume you know what is required.
- 5. Do not assume that someone will write a letter for you. You must ask them.
- 6. For letters of recommendation, give who you ask adequate time to complete it.
- 7. If essays are needed, make sure they are completed timely and have **correct spelling**, **grammar and punctuation**. Ask a teacher or counselor to proofread your work.
- 8. Please complete the *entire application*! You will not be considered if it's incomplete.
- 9. Look for scholarships on your own, but do not pay for any scholarship searches.
- 10. Please be aware that what you post on social media is out there for the world to see. Do not assume that scholarship committee members will not see your posts.
- 11. Search the internet, TikTok, and even where your parents/guardians work for scholarship opportunities.
- 12. Be creative! There is a lot of money up for grabs for college!

Students may submit the FAFSA once it opens through April 15, 2024, for grants and loans to attend college during the 2024-25 school year. Students and parents will sign in using a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID). Mrs. Rose, the College Connection Coach, is available in the Guidance Office to help students and parents who have questions about the FAFSA. When students meet with Mrs. Rose, it is helpful if they know what progress has been made in completing the FSA ID and FAFSA.

Workforce Ready Grant 👼 👺



The Next Level Jobs Workforce Ready Grant pays the **tuition** and **mandatory fees** for eligible high-value certificate programs at Ivy Tech Community College, Vincennes University, Indiana Institute of Technology, or other approved providers. The grant is available for two (2) years and covers up to the number of credits required by the qualifying program. The grant does not cover courses that do not directly apply to the student's certificate program. Program-specific fees and equipment are not covered.

The <u>qualifying high-value certificate programs</u> were selected based on employer demand, wages, job placements and program completion rate. These programs are aligned with Indiana's highest demand sectors:

- Advanced Manufacturing
- Building & Construction
- Health Sciences
- IT & Business Services
- Transportation & Logistics

Indiana College Core

By taking advantage of dual credit, AP, and additional courses, students can earn 30 college credits within 6 competencies. By completing this, students will earn a technical certificate before they graduate high school which completes their first year of college. Nurse Notes


A meningococcal booster dose is <u>required</u> for students entering grade 12. The meningococcal booster is not required for students in Grade 12 who received dose #1 on or after their 16th birthday. Students are also <u>required</u> to have both doses of Hepatitis A vaccines. Please talk with your child's healthcare provider about the meningococcal and Hepatitis A vaccine.

Tis the season to get sick! As we head into the cold & flu season I just want to remind everyone that if you are sick to please stay home. If your student has a fever (>100.2), you must be fever free for 24 hours *without* the use of fever reducing medications. If your student is experiencing vomiting or diarrhea, they must have no vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school.


