## Parent/Observer Canvas Instructions Grade 3-12

We encourage all parents/guardians to read all the instructions before setting up your account.

What is a pairing code and how do I use a pairing code as an observer?

A pairing code connects you as an observer to your child's canvas account.

Observers must have a pairing code when creating his/her account in the Canvas Parent app or web browser. Observers can link to additional students using pairing codes from their User Settings once the initial account is established. Learn more about these options below:

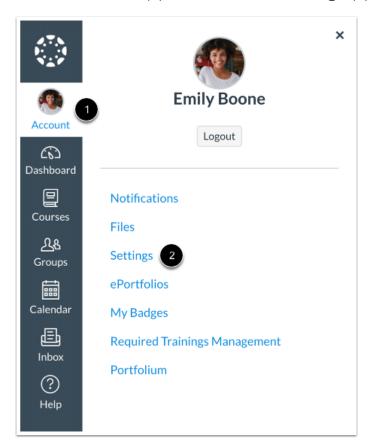
# **BEGIN HERE:**

The student MUST provide you with a pairing code in order to get access to his/her records. Follow the step below with him/her to obtain the pairing code. Pairing codes are case sensitive.

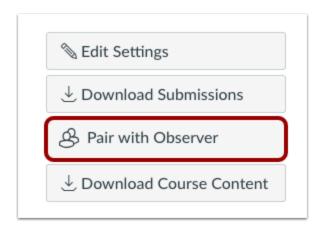
#### STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS TO OBTAIN PAIR CODE

#### **Student enters Canvas**

Click on **Account** (1) link. Then click **Settings** (2) link

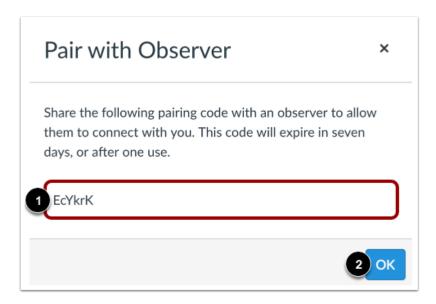


Click the **Pair with Observer** button (located in right hand menu)



Copy the six-digit alphanumeric pairing code [1]. You will need to share the code with the observer who will link to your account.

To close the window, click the **OK** button [2].



NOTE: Pairing codes are case sensitive. The pairing code will expire after seven days or its first use.

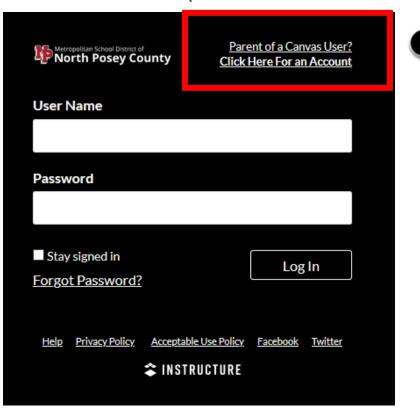

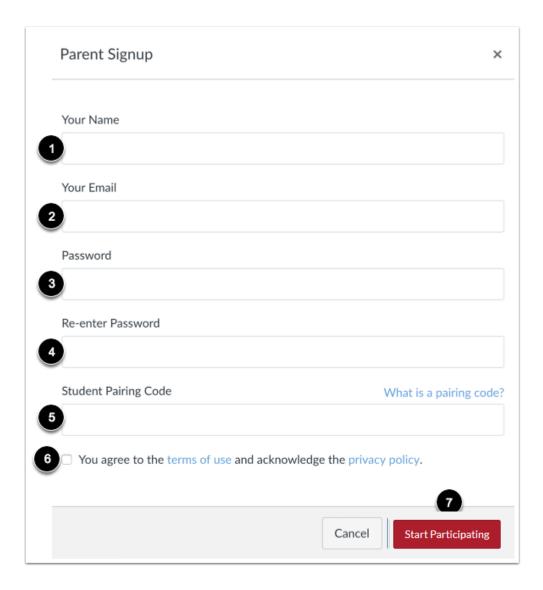

### Create Canvas Account (Click the Parent of a Canvas User link (1))

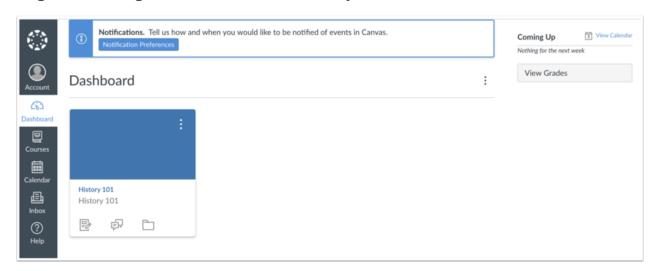


#### **Enter Signup Details as follows:**

- 1. Enter your name in the **Your Name** field.

- 3. Enter your password in the **Password** field.
- 4. Re-enter your password in the **Re-enter Password** field.
- 5. Enter a pairing code to link your account to your student in the **Student Pairing Code** field.
- 6. Agree to the terms of use by clicking the **You agree to the terms of use** checkbox.
- 7. Click the **Start Participating** button.



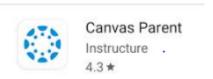
Begin Observing – The calendar view is very beneficial for observers.

Canvas is actively improving our native mobile applications to support as many Canvas features as possible. Instructure has one native mobile application for observers free for download on both phones and tablets.

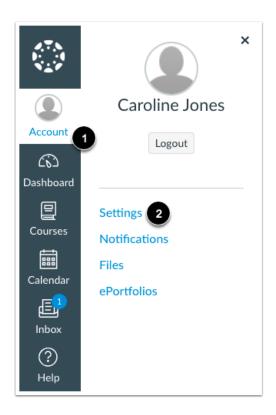

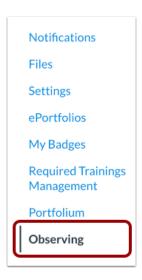

### ADD ADDITIONAL STUDENTS TO YOUR ACCOUNT

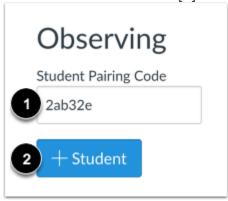
Open User Settings by clicking on the Account link [1], then click the Settings link [2].

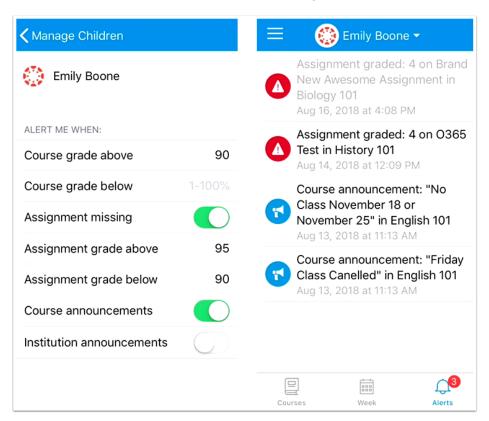
